Dungeness B Power Station – 27th, 28th February and 1st March 2017

Dear Parent/Carer,

We are delighted to offer our year 8 students the opportunity to visit Dungeness B power station on one of the following days, Monday 27th February, Tuesday 28th February and Wednesday 1st March 2017. Students will be allocated a day as they return this slip, we will fill up the Monday trip first then Tuesday and Wednesday. I will send a letter home advising you of which day your child will be visiting Dungeness. Students will be able to enjoy a day at the Power Station participating in a range of different activities that will support our work on renewable and non-renewable energy. The cost of this trip will be £5.00p

We will travel to Dungeness via coach, leaving Rye Sports Centre at 9am, arriving back to school at approximately 3pm. You will need to indicate if you are happy for your child to be dismissed from Rye Sports Centre slightly early or if you wish them to return to College to be dismissed at the usual time of 3.20. Students will participate in a range activities. These will include a guided tour of the power station to see how it operates and a STEM activity looking at alternative methods of generating electricity.

Students should wear their own clothing on the day, however, they will have to abide by the strict dress code enforced by the Power Station. **All students have to wear long trousers (no rips) no thin leggings and fully covered footwear – trainers etc. They are an industrial site and skirts and tights are not permitted.** Any student who does not meet these strict guidelines will not be permitted on the trip. All safety clothing and equipment will be provided by Dungeness. In addition students will need to bring a packed lunch with them. Drinking water will be available throughout the day but they should bring some with them for the journey.

Please be aware that we reserve the right to remove a student from this trip, if the student does not demonstrate a high standard of behaviour/adhere to the rules set by Rye College. Payment for this trip can be made to student reception, via cash or cheque (payable to 'Rye College'). Please also return the attached permission slip to Student Reception by the **4th February 2017.**
