Dear families,

Re: Strike Action

I hope this letter finds you well.

I am writing to you again in anticipation of the third and fourth days of industrial action, scheduled for **Wednesday, 15th and Thursday, 16th March 2023**.

While the planned action is as a result of a national dispute between the unions and the government, and not Rye College, it is important that we respond accordingly. As such, the senior leadership team at Rye College has been working closely with staff in order to plan for the day. At this stage, we understand that a significant number of colleagues from Rye College will be taking industrial action.

We have looked at the school timetable for that day to ensure we can still manage the safe supervision of students while minimising the impact on learning with reduced staffing levels in place.

Therefore, if the strike action goes ahead, *Rye College will remain open for **restricted attendance** (absence will be authorised).*

Students should remain at home during Wednesday, 15th and Thursday, 16th March unless specifically invited to attend.

The arrangements for on-site provision are as follows:

- *ALL Year 11s are invited attend Science masterclasses between 11am and 1pm (please enter school via reception);*
- *Y11 students taking PE GCSE and/or Sport Science are required to attend all day;*
- *For all other students, the school day will follow usual timings;*
- *Students will be supervised by teachers and associate staff;*
- *Students will complete the same work as set for those off-site;*
- *The Safeguarding, Student and SEND Hub team will be available throughout;*
- *There will first aid trained staff on-site throughout;*
- *The canteen will be open and food will be available.*

Families of those students, who are being invited in, will be contacted separately over the coming days. If you are a critical worker (click [link](#) for definition), please contact us, if you wish your child/ren to attend school on **Wednesday, 15th and Thursday, 16th March** via office@ryecollege.co.uk.

For students remaining at home, work will be posted via ClassCharts for each year group from across a range of subjects.
