Dear families,

**Re: Strike Action**

I hope this letter finds you well.

I am writing to you again in anticipation of industrial action, scheduled for **Wednesday, 5<sup>th</sup> July and Friday, 7<sup>th</sup> July 2023**.

While the planned action is as a result of a national dispute between the unions and the government, and not Rye College, it is important that we respond accordingly. As such, the senior leadership team at Rye College has been working closely with staff in order to plan for the day. At this stage, we understand that a significant number of colleagues from Rye College will be taking industrial action.

We have looked at the school timetable for the dates in question to ensure we can still manage the safe supervision of students while minimising the impact on learning with reduced staffing levels in place.

Therefore, if the strike action goes ahead, *Rye College will remain open for **restricted attendance** (absence will be authorised). The planned trips to Normandy and London will continue.*

***Students should remain at home during Wednesday, 5<sup>th</sup> and Friday, 7<sup>th</sup> July unless specifically invited to attend.***

The arrangements for on-site provision are as follows:

- **Wednesday, 5<sup>th</sup> July – Y10 Romeo and Juliet Theatre Trip will go ahead as per arrangements;**
- **Wednesday, 5<sup>th</sup> July – Paris and Normandy trip will return as per arrangements;**
- *For all other students, the school day will follow usual timings;*
- *Students will be supervised by teachers and associate staff;*
- *Students will complete the same work as set for those off-site;*
- *The Safeguarding, Student and SEND Hub team will be available throughout;*
- *There will first aid trained staff on-site throughout;*
- *The canteen will be open and food will be available.*

Families of those students, who are being invited in, will be contacted separately over the coming days.
